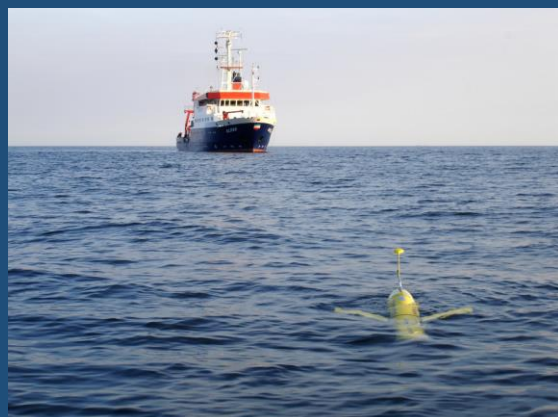


New technologies for the Baltic marine science community!
