The Alfred Wegener Institute Helmholtz Center for Polar and Marine Research (AWI) is planning to replace the existing polar research vessel **POLARSTERN** by a multifunctional ice-breaking polar research and supply vessel **POLARSTERN II** for the Arctic and Antarctic operational areas, as well as for the supply of the research station **Neumayer III** in Antarctica.
