

LNG handling in practice:

Hands-on LNG training on board of MS Bergensfjord

29th & 30th of May, Bergen & Stavanger

During the two days you will get practical insights into how Norway tackles the challenges around sea- and land-based LNG handling. On board of the *MS Bergensfjord* you will get the unique opportunity to join a LNG course in real life situation- covering the ship side of LNG training, including a visit of the engine- and tank rooms, the bunker station and bridge. Furthermore, you will attend a bunkering and get to meet all involved authorities that set the framework for a safe LNG handling. The visit to a LNG plant will provide a hands-on demonstration of LNG production.

Flight to Bergen

From Hamburg: SAS or Norwegian Airshuttle (via Copenhagen or Oslo)

From Amsterdam: KLM direct flights

From Groningen Airport Eelde: SAS (via Copenhagen)

How to get from Bergen airport to Hurtigruten Terminal

Travel with the Bergen airport bus from Bergen Airport to the centre of Bergen. Leave the bus at *Festplassen airport bus stop* (second stop in the very centre of Bergen). From Festplassen you can walk (approx. 850 meters): Walk 220 meters east to the street Haakonsgaten, walk north (right) 630 meters in the street Haakonsgaten, you are now at the Hurtigruten Terminal.

Flight to Oslo

Both Norwegian Airshuttle and SAS fly every hour from Stavanger to Oslo

Upon arrival at Oslo Airport

Travel by train: Flytoget to Oslo S / Nationaltheater / Skøyen (190 NOK) or NSB (101 NOK) The Flytoget leaves every 10 minutes and brings you to the city centre within 20 minutes. Please note that taking a taxi from the airport is a very expensive alternative.
